

SOMETHING TO CONSIDER

A question has been rolling around in my mind for some time now, and I talked about it to the men at Men's Bible Study a couple of weeks ago. I am going to mention it to you because I feel that this is something we, as Christians in our modern world, have been conditioned to NOT think about. The question is preceded by a qualifying statement which will help us understand the real intent of the question.

Here we go:

If the Biblical account of creation is true, God created human beings with the intent that humans would be physical representatives of God in the world, and would make known the character of God in words, actions, and thoughts, as man cares for and benefits from all the functions of a fruitful planet. This was God's plan for man in this universe He created. The Garden of Eden conflict with the devil was a resounding defeat for humanity. Sin became the accepted norm for a lost world. Adam fell far short of God's plan, and history has provided an ample commentary on human failure. The inability to live as God designed us to live has been so complete that, even as Christians, many believe that there is nothing but perpetual defeat possible, until we die and go to heaven. We no longer believe that it is possible to be pleasing to God on this pitiful planet, or even to strive for it.
