CONSIDER THIS

The final point mentioned in our Statement of Faith has to do with the ordinances of the Church. The first of these is Baptism, which we have mentioned has been considered as a public profession of faith in Jesus Christ, as we identify with His death, burial and resurrection by being immersed in water. This is also a sign of our spiritual "new" birth, and our desire to be joined with others who are followers of Jesus. The command to baptize believers was given to the New Testament Church, and we gladly receive those who follow the Savior in baptism into the fellowship of the Church.

The second ordinance which we observe is Communion, or the Lord's Supper which we celebrate once a month. This is a memorial by which we remember that His body was broken for us, and His blood was shed for us on the cross, that we might receive forgiveness for our sins, and eternal life with Him. This participation in the Lord's Supper is a reminder of the great Love and Mercy that He has shown us, in giving us life everlasting.

The message today addresses some details of this memorial supper, which is similar to the Passover Meal commemorating the passing of the angel of death over the Hebrew children in Egypt. Pertinent Scriptures will be:
