## CONSIDER THIS

We have been considering the beliefs which are included in our statement of faith. In reality, our statement includes everything that the Bible tells us of God, and His relationship to this world, and to man. We have tried to summarize this body of beliefs so we can learn how to share what we believe with others. For the next few weeks, we will be speaking about our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Today, we offer Communion to all who profess faith in Jesus, and present the Truths the Cup and Bread represent about our Savior. The Bible says we should observe this ordinance to remember His sacrificial death for us, until He comes again in power and glory.

This is what we believe:

The Holy Bible, the Old Testament and New Testament, is the Word of God, our source of Truth. - 2 Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 4:12; 1 Peter 1:25; 2 Peter 1:19-21.

We believe in One God, revealed to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.  
- Matthew 28:19,20; 1 John 5:7,8.

Jesus Christ is the virgin born Son of God, Savior and Lord. - Philippians 2:5-7;  
Matthew 1:18; John 1:1-5, 14.

The Holy Spirit is God, Who regenerates the lost, and indwells the hearts of believers. - John 16:7-14.

Satan is the perpetrator of all evil and is the deceiver of the whole world."  
- Genesis 3:1; Job 1:6,7; 2 Corinthians 8:14;  
John 12:31; Luke 10:18.

The Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross, was buried in the ground, was physically resurrected,

ascended bodily into the heavens and is now our mediator seated at the right hand of God.

- Matthew 27:45-50; Mark 15: 42-47; John 20:11-18;  
Luke 24:50-53; Mark 16:19, 20; Colossians 3:1.

The Lord Jesus Christ is coming again to claim His redeemed ones, to judge the Nations, and to establish His Kingdom.

- 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; Zechariah 14: 4-11; Revelation 19: 11-16; 20: 1-6; 1 Thessalonians 1:10: 5:9 and Revelation 3:10.

The Lord Jesus Christ, by the grace of God, experienced death for those who will believe, and all must be "born again" or be forever lost.

- John 3:1-8; 2 Thessalonians 1:3-10.

The saved will be resurrected to everlasting life and communion with God, and the lost alienated to everlasting damnation.

Water baptism:

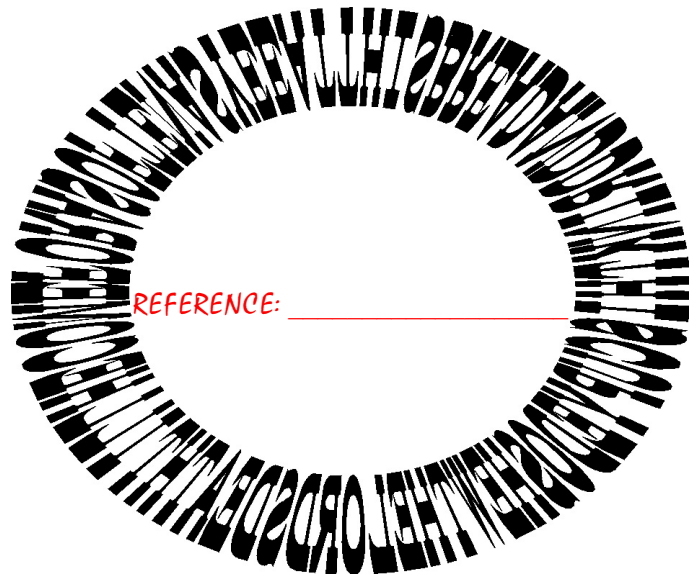
-Matthew 28: 19-20; Acts 2:41; Romans 6:3-5; 10.
