CONSIDER THIS

We have been considering the beliefs which are included in our statement of faith. In reality, our statement includes everything that the Bible tells us of God, and His relationship to this world, and to man. The Bible says we should observe this ordinance to remember His sacrificial death for us, until He comes again in power and glory.

This is what we believe:

The Holy Bible, the Old Testament and New Testament, is the Word of God, our source of Truth. - 2 Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 4:12; 1 Peter 1:25;

2 Peter 1:19-21.

We believe in One God, revealed to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

- Matthew 28:19,20; 1 John 5:7,8.

Jesus Christ is the virgin born Son of God,

Savior and Lord. - Philippians 2:5-7;

Matthew 1:18; John 1:1-5, 14.

The Holy Spirit is God, Who regenerates the lost, and indwells the hearts of believers. - John 16:7-14.

Satan is the perpetrator of all evil and is the deceiver of the whole world."

The Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross, was buried in the ground, was physically resurrected,

Water baptism:


-Matthew 28: 19-20; Acts 2:41; Romans 6:3-5; 10.
