The Word of God clearly teaches two ordinances for the Church to help us remember His wonderful grace:

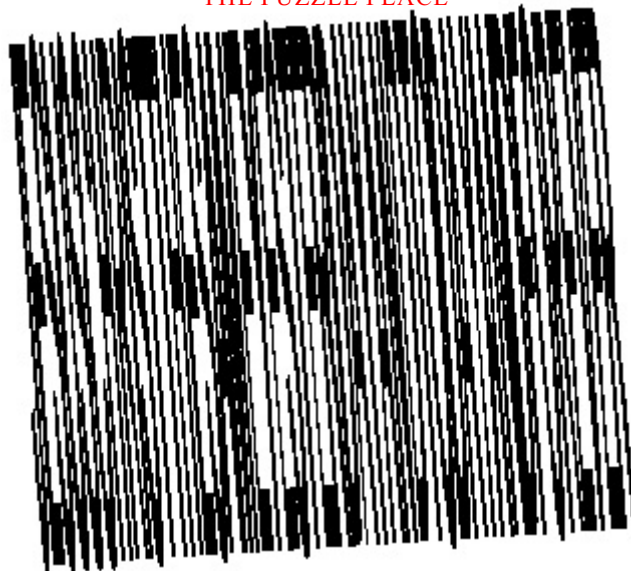
Water baptism:
