CONSIDER THIS

This is our Statement of Faith; the doctrines which define who we are in Christ. We have come to the place of recognizing that we are in a relationship with Jesus Christ, by grace, through faith in His finished work of redemption on the cross, and His resurrection from the grave. Because of this relationship, we have been set apart unto God, and have been set at variance with the world. This is not our doing, but because we now belong to God, we are no longer accepted by the world, nor do we fit into its system. The division is sweet and complete, and opposed by the enemy of God, who counts us as enemies as well. The sword of the Spirit is the Word of God, wielded to divide good from evil, pure from impure, and clean from filthy. When we choose to follow Jesus Christ, we also choose to unfollow the world, which is under the influence of the evil one, Satan.

This is what we believe:

The Holy Bible, the Old Testament and New Testament, is the Word of God, our source of Truth. - 2 Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 4:12; 1 Peter 1:25; 2 Peter 1:19-21.

We believe in One God, revealed to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. - Matthew 28:19,20; 1 John 5:7,8.

Jesus Christ is the virgin born Son of God, Savior and Lord . -John 1:1-14. Hebrews 1:1-14; Philippians 2:5-11; Colossians 1:9-23

The Holy Spirit is God, Who regenerates the lost, and indwells the hearts of believers. - John 16:7-14.

Satan is the perpetrator of all evil and is the deceiver of thewhole world." - Genesis 3:1; Job 1:6,7; 2 Corinthians 8:14; John 12:31: Luke 10:18.

The Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross, was buried in the ground, was physically resurrected, ascended bodily into the heavens and is now our mediator seated at the right hand of God. - Matthew 27:45-50; Mark 15: 42-47; John 20:11-18; Luke 24:50-53; Mark 16:19, 20; Colossians 3:1. The Lord Jesus Christ is coming again to claim His redeemed ones, to judge the Nations, and to establish His Kingdom.

Water baptism:


-Matthew 28: 19-20; Acts 2:41; Romans 6:3-5; 10.
