CONSIDER THIS

This is our Statement of Faith; the doctrines which define who we are in Christ. We have come to the place of recognizing that we are in a relationship with Jesus Christ, by grace, through faith in His finished work of redemption on the cross, and His resurrection from the grave. Because of this relationship, we have been set apart unto God, and have been set at variance with the world. This is not our doing, but because we now belong to God, we are no longer accepted by the world, nor do we fit into its system. We are saved by grace, through faith in Jesus Christ, His life and atoning death for us. We are sanctified by the work of the Holy Spirit, Who is our focus today. We will see a little of His work in the Old Testament, then consider apostolic times and His work in us today. It will probably take some time to digest.

This is what we believe:

The Holy Bible, the Old Testament and New Testament, is the Word of God, our source of Truth. - 2 Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 4:12; 1 Peter 1:25; 2 Peter 1:19-21.

We believe in One God, revealed to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. - Matthew 28:19,20; 1 John 5:7,8.

Jesus Christ is the virgin born Son of God, Savior and Lord . - John 1:1-14. Hebrews 1:1-14; Philippians 2:5-11; Colossians 1:9-23

The Holy Spirit is God, Who regenerates the lost, and indwells the hearts of believers. - John 16:7-14.

Satan is the perpetrator of all evil and is the deceiver of the whole world." - Genesis 3:1; Job 1:6,7; 2 Corinthians 8:14;

John 12:31; Luke 10:18.

The Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross, was buried in the ground, was physically resurrected, ascended bodily into the heavens and is now our mediator seated at the right hand of God. - Matthew 27:45-50;

Mark 15: 42-47; John 20:11-18; Luke 24:50-53; Mark 16:19, 20; Colossians 3:1.

The Lord Jesus Christ is coming again to claim His redeemed ones, to judge the Nations, and to establish His Kingdom.

The Lord Jesus Christ, by the grace of God, experienced death for those who will believe, and all must be "born again" or be forever lost.
