Again in 2024, we will have a booth at the Adams County Fair from Thursday through Sunday. In addition, we will conduct our Sunday morning worship service on the Midway at the Fairgrounds, for the third straight year. We will have the service at 10 A.M. on August 25th, and will not have a service at White Creek on that day. The entire Church Family is invited to join Fair goers and Fair workers in worship and praise on August 25th, at 10 A.M.

CONSIDER THIS

This is our Statement of Faith; the doctrines which define who we are in Christ. Our progress through the statement has brought us to consider Who God is, what He does, and what we are to do in response to Him. We have a personal relationship with God, not just an intellectual knowledge of Him. The Bible tells us that He has created us, nurtured us, and when we turned away from Him, He sought us out and provided a Savior for us. Part of our plan is to point out the highlighted sections weekly in the message. This week we are finishing a short series about the Holy Spirit.

This is what we believe:

The Holy Bible, the Old Testament and New Testament, is the Word of God, our source of Truth. - 2 Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 4:12; 1 Peter 1:25; 2 Peter 1:19-21.

We believe in One God, revealed to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. - Matthew 28:19,20; 1 John 5:7,8.

Jesus Christ is the virgin born Son of God, Savior and Lord. - John 1:1-14. Hebrews 1:1-14; Philippians 2:5-11; Colossians 1:9-23

The Holy Spirit is God, Who regenerates the lost, and indwells the hearts of believers. - John 16:7-14.

Satan is the perpetrator of all evil and is the deceiver of the whole world." - Genesis 3:1; Job 1:6,7; 2 Corinthians 8:14; John 12:31; Luke 10:18.

The Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross, was buried in the ground, was physically resurrected, ascended bodily into the heavens and is now our mediator seated at the right hand of God. - Matthew 27:45-50; Mark 15: 42-47; John 20:11-18; Luke 24:50-53; Mark 16:19, 20; Colossians 3:1.

The Lord Jesus Christ is coming again to claim His redeemed ones, to judge the Nations, and to establish His Kingdom. - 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; Zechariah 14: 4-11; Revelation 19: 11-16; 20: 1-6; I Thessalonians 1:10: 5:9 and Revelation 3:10.

The Lord Jesus Christ, by the grace of God, experienced death for those who will believe, and all must be "born again" or be forever lost.

- John 3:1-8; 2 Thessalonians 1:3-10.

The saved will be resurrected to everlasting life and communion with God, and the lost alienated to everlasting damnation.
