CONSIDER THIS

This is our Statement of Faith; the doctrines which define who we are in Christ. This week we are considering the person of Satan. In a world that recognizes the evil that is possible because of Satan's influence, we have many that do not believe that Satan exists. We believe in One God, revealed to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. - Matthew 28:19,20; 1 John 5:7,8.

Jesus Christ is the virgin born Son of God, Savior and Lord. - John 1:1-14. Hebrews 1:1-14; Philippians 2:5-11; Colossians 1:9-23

The Holy Spirit is God, Who regenerates the lost, and indwells the hearts of believers. - John 16:7-14.

Satan is the perpetrator of all evil and is the deceiver of the whole world." - Genesis 3:1; Job 1:6,7; 2 Corinthians 8:4; John 12:31; Luke 10:18.

The Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross, was buried in the ground, was physically resurrected, ascended bodily into the heavens and is now our mediator seated at the right hand of God. - Matthew 27:45-50; Mark 15: 42-47; John 20:11-18; Luke 24:50-53; Mark 16:19, 20; Colossians 3:1.

The Lord Jesus Christ is coming again to claim His redeemed ones, to judge the Nations, and to establish His Kingdom. - 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; Zechariah 14: 4-11; Revelation 19: 11-16; 20: 1-6; I Thessalonians 1:10: 5:9 and Revelation 3:10.

The Lord Jesus Christ, by the grace of God, experienced death for those who will believe, and all must be "born again" or be forever lost. - John 3:1-8; 2 Thessalonians 1:3-10.

The saved will be resurrected to everlasting life and communion with God, and the lost alienated to everlasting damnation. - Romans 2:7-11; 3:23; 6:23; 1 John 5:20; John 5:24-29.

Water baptism:

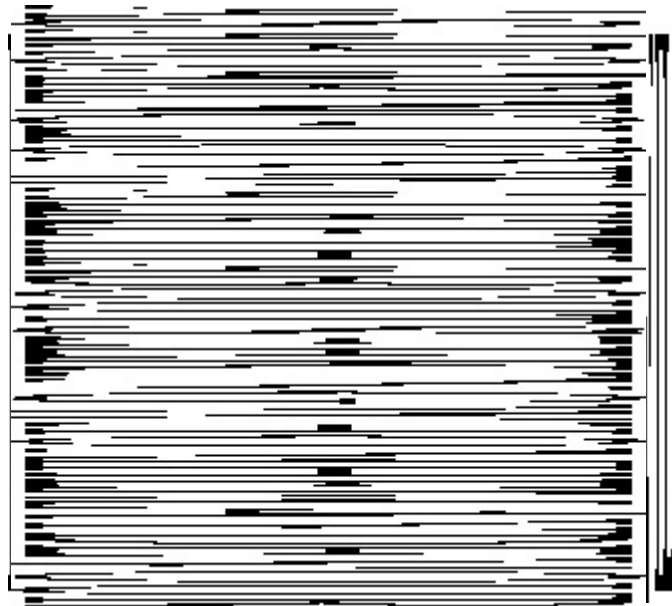
-Matthew 28: 19-20; Acts 2:41; Romans 6:3-5; 10.
