We had a very good week at the Adams County Fair this year, capped by the Worship Service on Sunday morning, with over 70 in attendance. We want to thank each of you who attended, and praise God for bringing others to join us in the service.

CONSIDER THIS

This is our Statement of Faith; the doctrines which define who we are in Christ Jesus told His disciples, "You believe in God, believe also in Me." It is one thing to believe in God as an impersonal "FORCE" who created the world, and another thing, entirely, to believe in His Son, Jesus Christ, who died on the cross for the sins of man. It is one thing to believe in the existence of the Son of God, as we believe in the existence of, say, George Washington, and another thing to place our trust in His sacrificial death for us, on the cross, that we might have everlasting life, through Him. It is by God's grace toward us, through the gift of faith, given to us by God, that we are able to receive forgiveness for sin, and life eternal, for the praise and glory of God. Today, we consider that Jesus died for all who truly believe. The result is that we are "born again!" if we do not believe, we are lost forever.

This is what we believe:

The Holy Bible, the Old Testament and New Testament, is the Word of God, our source of Truth. - 2 Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 4:12; 1 Peter 1:25; 2 Peter 1:19-21.

We believe in One God, revealed to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. - Matthew 28:19,20; 1 John 5:7,8.

Jesus Christ is the virgin born Son of God, Savior and Lord. - John 1:1-14. Hebrews 1:1-14; Philippians 2:5-11; Colossians 1:9-23

The Holy Spirit is God, Who regenerates the lost, and indwells the hearts of believers. - John 16:7-14.

Satan is the perpetrator of all evil and is the deceiver of the whole world." - Genesis 3:1; Job 1:6,7; 2 Corinthians 8:4; John 12:31; Luke 10:18.

The Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross, was buried in the ground, was physically resurrected, ascended bodily into the heavens and is now our mediator seated at the right hand of God. - Matthew 27:45-50;

Mark 15: 42-47; John 20:11-18; Luke 24:50-53; Mark 16:19, 20; Colossians 3:1.

The Lord Jesus Christ is coming again to claim His redeemed ones, to judge the Nations, and to establish His Kingdom.

- 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; Zechariah 14: 4-11; Revelation 19: 11-16; 20: 1-6; I Thessalonians 1:10: 5:9 and Revelation 3:10.

The Lord Jesus Christ, by the grace of God, experienced death for those who will believe, and all must be "born again" or be forever lost. - John 3:1-8; 2 Thessalonians 1:3-10.

The saved will be resurrected to everlasting life and communion with God, and the lost alienated to everlasting damnation.
