CONSIDER THIS

This is what we believe:

The Holy Bible, the Old Testament and New Testament, is the Word of God, our source of Truth. - 2 Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 4:12; 1 Peter 1:25; 2 Peter 1:19-21.

We believe in One God, revealed to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. - Matthew 28:19,20; 1 John 5:7,8.

Jesus Christ is the virgin born Son of God, Savior and Lord. - John 1:1-14. Hebrews 1:1-14; Philippians 2:5-11; Colossians 1:9-23

The Holy Spirit is God, Who regenerates the lost, and indwells the hearts of believers. - John 16:7-14.

Satan is the perpetrator of all evil and is the deceiver of the whole world." - Genesis 3:1; Job 1:6,7; 2 Corinthians 8:4; John 12:31; Luke 10:18.

The Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross, was buried in the ground, was physically resurrected, ascended bodily into the heavens and is now our mediator seated at the right hand of God. - Matthew 27:45-50; Mark 15: 42-47; John 20:11-18; Luke 24:50-53; Mark 16:19, 20; Colossians 3:1.

The Lord Jesus Christ is coming again to claim His redeemed ones, to judge the Nations, and to establish His Kingdom. - 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; Zechariah 14: 4-11; Revelation 19: 11-16; 20: 1-6; 1 Thessalonians 1:10: 5:9 and Revelation 3:10.

The Lord Jesus Christ, by the grace of God, experienced death for those who will believe, and all must be "born again" or be forever lost. - John 3:1-8; 2 Thessalonians 1:3-10.

The saved will be resurrected to everlasting life and communion with God, and the lost alienated to everlasting damnation. - Romans 2:7-11; 3:23; 6:23; 1 John 5:20; John 5:24-29.

The Word of God clearly teaches two ordinances for the Church to help us remember His wonderful grace:

Water baptism: -Matthew 28: 19-20; Acts 2:41; Romans 6:3-5; 10.

The Lord's Supper: - Luke 22:9-20; 1 Corinthians 11:23-29.

This final section of our Statement of Faith describes the two ordinances of the Church that are given in the New Testament. This statement contains the core beliefs that the founders of this Church thought were important for each member to embrace. This is our Statement of Faith; the doctrines which define who we are in Christ. Those who have joined together to compose the Body of Christ in this location, have committed to the Lord and to one another to live out these, and all other Scriptural ideals in such a way that Jesus Christ is glorified, and the Gospel is effectively communicated to all those in our sphere of influence. For the Church to function effectively, we need all who are called of God to join with us, and collectively exercise the spiritual and natural gifts with which we are endowed. These last two items in the statement reflect the initial profession of faith as a person first commits to the gathering of saints, and the ongoing communion and fellowship of faith, hope, and love. This local Body of Christ is to be an enduring experience of encouragement and accountability, as we make our way through this world of sin and death. We really need the Church, to be THE CHURCH - the BODY OF CHRIST.
