This Church has its roots in Congregationalism. It was planted in Adams County in 1870, as an outreach to farmers and others who populated the rural areas outside of the big cities. Through the years, other such Churches were planted throughout this land; some flourished as their areas grew in population, and others closed when the need for them waned. White Creek was a small community which grew for awhile, and then lost population when the railroad came through the area, and the State highway bypassed the town by a couple of miles. Throughout these changing times, the faithful members of this Church continued to hold services and evangelize the surrounding neighbors.

Although the Church has not appreciably increased in size through the years, it has remained faithful to the Great Commission, and the Gospel of Jesus Christ. When the beliefs of its founding denomination became very liberal, the Church continued to believe the Bible, as the Word of God, and became an independent Bible Church. When the local school closed and consolidated with other County schools, the Church continued to shine the light of the Gospel in this location, and support mission works in other parts of the world. This is the legacy of White Creek Church.

We are still here because of the faithfulness of our God, Who has blessed us beyond measure, and the people of the Church, who have often given their time, resources and faithful attendance through all these years. As an independent Church, we conduct our own affairs, with each member playing an important role, under the leadership of the Holy Spirit. The Head of the Church is Jesus Christ, and we all have gifts, under His control, which helps the Church fulfill its mission. Please be praying as the members of the Church gather to conduct the business of the Church on November 9th. If you believe that God would have you become a member of the Church, and become a partner with us in ministry, please speak to the pastor. May God bless you all, and continue to bless His Church in White Creek.

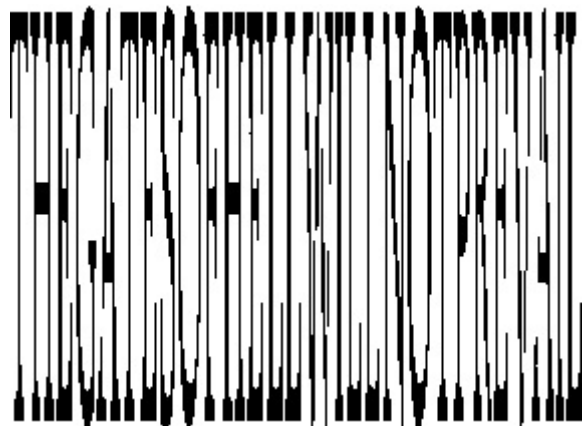
