
CONSIDER THIS

The next few weeks are important in the Christian calendar because they lead us to consider the last days of Jesus Christ upon this earth, before He went to the cross, dying there for our sins. Actually, to speak of His last days here is not exactly accurate. The physical body which He lived in from birth to death, was no longer available, but He said that when He went back to heaven, He would send the Holy Spirit to take His place here. This spiritual entity would be with us, and IN us. We generally connect this with the idea of "being born again."

We are no longer aware of the physical presence of the Lord, as the first disciples were, as they walked and talked with Him. We have often convinced ourselves that this makes the Christian life more difficult now than it was then. In fact, we have considered living a Christian life as an impossibility. In reality, it IS impossible for us to live as Jesus lived while on this earth, in our own wisdom and strength. We ARE merely human beings, after all, and He was/IS GOD! Many of us have settled into a semi-comfortable, mildly unsatisfying existence of minor victories and multiple failures in this world, giving in to the corrupting influences of the persistent enemy of our souls, the destroyer of the work of God. We are hoping for an easy way out before the world implodes, thankful that God gives us Grace.

I do believe that there is more than this to the Christian Life! The Lord still walks with us in this world. He said He would take care of us, in this life and throughout eternity. We have just stopped short of fully trusting in Him completely. God has given us much more than we have received. Have you trusted in Christ as your Savior, to receive the forgiveness of your sins? Are you trusting Christ as your Life, allowing Him to live His life through you? There are some things that are not automatic, we must choose them for ourselves. As we begin to contemplate the CROSS, and the resurrection, let's commit ourselves to become all that God intends us to be.
