CONSIDER THIS

I just heard a report the other day about how busy we Americans are today - - justification for the little time we have for the Lord, or the church, or other believers. Sadly, many professing Christians had rather be out among the people and things of the world than with the people of God. We have more in common with the people of the world - those who are hell-bound and don't care about God. Many are more inclined to join family and friends for fun and frolic almost anywhere else but the Church. Many just hang out at home watching mindless stuff on TV, or playing pointless games of chance or violence on the internet. We have sold out our spiritual growth in order to keep pace with those who are going nowhere. There are those who get their "spirituality and inspiration" from the multitudes of entertainment venues available down on Main Street or in the convenience of their own home. We were appalled, years ago, when a famous preacher advertised that Church would be conducted at the drive-in theater in town, and the whole family could attend Church in their pajamas. I imagine they could visit the concession stand during the offertory and munch popcorn during the entertaining sermon. They could then drive off at the end, and head back to their "worldly" life

I wrote this to encourage you to reevaluate your commitment level to the Lord, and to give Him more of yourself. All this we say and do is admonition against falling away from God, into the abyss of worldliness. Please, learn to walk that fine line between liberty and license. The world is filled with distractions. Many want to pretend that much of this is innocent and fun, with no moral bent at all, but the deception of the enemy is designed to have a "frog in the kettle effect" on us. (I looked that expression up on the internet, and even Artificial Intelligence knows what it means.) The more we have on our plate, the less time we have for God, and the things of God. In the short term and the long run, we are targets for the fiery darts of the archenemy of God. There is no one who is immune or adept enough to dodge all the missiles without the Lord's help. If we do not intentionally draw closer to the Lord, we will wind up farther away. Remember the "wide gate; narrow gate" principle. There is no middle ground, Pastor Sam
