CONSIDER THIS

The news agencies are filled with the accounts of the shooting of Charlie Kirk in Utah this past week. We need to make mention of this occasion, because it accentuates the growing problem we face in this country, the land of the free. We are very proud of our freedoms which are guaranteed by the constitution and enforced under the rule of law, except when they aren't.

Whether you liked the things Mr. Kirk said or not, he was afforded the right to express his beliefs under the constitution, and was exercising that right under the law. I am not writing this to condone what Charlie's message was, or to defend his manner of expression, but to sound the warning that violence is not the proper response.

It is true that Charlie Kirk was a supporter of the MAGA movement, and many condemn him for espousing those views. He also was an avowed Christian, and much of his rhetoric was in defense of Christian views and values. I don't personally know enough about him to pass judgment on him, but many others who did know him believe that he is with the Lord today.

We do not have to endorse his every viewpoint in order to condemn the violence that took his life. It is widely known that he often told his audiences the clear truth that is contained in the Bible, and defended Christian moral views such as opposition to abortion and biblical standards of marriage and family.


