CONSIDER THIS

It is more important than ever that we Christians live our lives as reflections of the life of Jesus Christ living in us. Our world is desperately broken and unredeemable by human means or ingenuity. We are way beyond the tipping point that leads to destruction, and many have become so jaded by corruption that they have given up on change, or have joined in on the great rebellion against the very Creator of life and order.

Much of humanity lives in ignorance of the standards of ethics and civility which have historically stood for thousands of years. We argue among ourselves about morality, right and wrong, and good and evil, ignoring the fact that the Creator and Father has given instructions on how we are to conduct ourselves, not just in our personal lives, but as people designed to live in concert with others in orderly society.
