## CONSIDER THIS

To follow through with the messages about FAITH, we will consider the three different uses of the word FAITH in the Bible.

- 1 Fidelity or faithfulness - Proverbs 20:5-6
2. Creed or doctrine - James 2:14-20
3. Reliance or trust - John 3:1-16

There is also a close resemblance between the words FAITH and BELIEVE, but there is a difference. People often use faith and belief interchangeably, but they're not the same thing. They overlap, but they operate on different levels.

Belief is primarily cognitive. It's about accepting that a statement is true.

"I believe the Earth orbits the sun."

"I believe my friend is honest."

"I believe God exists."

Belief is about propositional truth — mental assent to an idea.

Faith goes beyond belief. It includes belief, but adds trust, commitment, and often action.

You can believe a bridge is strong, but faith is walking across it.

You can believe a doctor is competent, but

faith is letting him operate.

You can believe God exists, but faith is entrusting your life to God. Faith is relational, experiential, and volitional. Belief says, "This is true." Faith says, "I'm staking my life on this." Not just theoretically, but in reality.

A simple way to put it:

Belief = acceptance of a claim.

Faith = trust + commitment based on that belief.

Someone has been quoted, "God said it, I believe it, that settles it." Sounds good, but the reality is that the progression falls apart if I don't know who God is, and have a relationship with Him. When Peter declared that he knew Jesus to be the Christ, Jesus said this: "flesh and blood hath not revealed *it* unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven." I can have faith in what the Father says, because He is Faithful. I know Him, and I can rely upon what He says.
